The mission of The Phoenix Center, working in partnership with families and community, is to develop the potential of each student with developmental disabilities and those on the autism spectrum ages five through 21 and to provide customized, unique, and individualized programs aligned with the New Jersey Student Learning Standards. Promoting the development of the whole student, we care for, educate, and empower our students and graduates so that they will develop life-centered skills which will prepare them for life beyond the classroom.



We have reserved Saturday, June 5, 2021 for our special 30th Anniversary Gala Fundraiser event at Macaluso's in Hawthorne, NJ. They have recently renovated, expanded their menu and offerings, and are rolling out the red carpet for us! Please save the date!

Because we had to cancel our Casino Night in May due to COVID-19 earlier this year, this Gala event is even more critical to our fundraising efforts. Our Casino Night cancellation represented a loss of approximately \$35,000 in fundraising contributions in support of our students and school programs.

These funds support program enhancements not covered by tuition from sending school districts. In the past, they have included:

- **Technology** such as SMARTBoards, Chromebooks, iPads, and more:
- A new mini-van to transport our students for our community-based initiatives and recreation and leisure programs, including therapeutic horseback riding, yoga, gymnastics and bowling;
- Playground improvements such as a new shade structure;
- Our Recreation and Leisure program that promotes socialization with a focus on community-based leisure activities such as bowling, gymnastics and horseback riding;
- Emergency support for Phoenix Center families in meeting our families most urgent needs as they arise.

You may remember completing a survey to determine if you wanted us to incorporate a Casino/gambling component to the Gala event. The results told us that the gambling component was really secondary for our typical attendees—if

Your responses indicated that you wanted to attend a get together, enjoy a great meal and evening with likeminded supporters of The Phoenix Center, and contribute to our mission and programming.

WE'VE COME A LONG WAY IN 30 YEARS

It is so gratifying to reflect on the success and growth the school has experienced in 30 years. We are eternally grateful to people like you for your ongoing belief, and support.

This year—with COVID-19 adding so much complexity to our educational lives—we are also so lucky and proud to have such a dedicated and creative staff. If you followed our regular updates from March to August on our website and on social media, you would have seen our school community, students, staff members and parents in action, making the most out of an unprecedented and challenging situation.

We have been successful because we have the resources and expertise to rethink how our students are served in an unconventional environment. And for that, we are a rare and fortunate school. On another happy note, here are a few high-level statistics of where we were and where we are now, 30 years later! We:

- **grew our annual student body** from 16 students and 12 staff in 1991 to an average of 140 students and 220 staff.
- developed our curriculum and program offerings that serve the whole child to best prepare them for *life beyond the classroom*, including 17 extra curricular activities, 33 job sites, and 34 community-based instruction (CBI) locations.
- rose as a leader in innovation using emerging technologies to better engage students in their education. Our SMARTBoards, Chromebooks, G-Suite for Education, robots (Nao and Photon) and our Funtronic Interactive Floor System are just a few examples of how we incorporate technology into our curriculum.

TPC really has come a long way and we are excited to see what the next 30 years holds for our learning community!
